KINCARDINE – All RESIDENTS ARE ASKED TO RUN WATER TO AVOID FROZEN PIPES

The colder than normal temperatures have resulted in the frost line penetrating deeper into the ground this year resulting in the potential of frozen water lines.

Residents are urged to take the following precaution:

Customers are asked to keep a steady stream of cold water running about the width of a pencil lead at an inside faucet farthest from the meter until further notice.

This keeps water moving, making it less likely to freeze.
